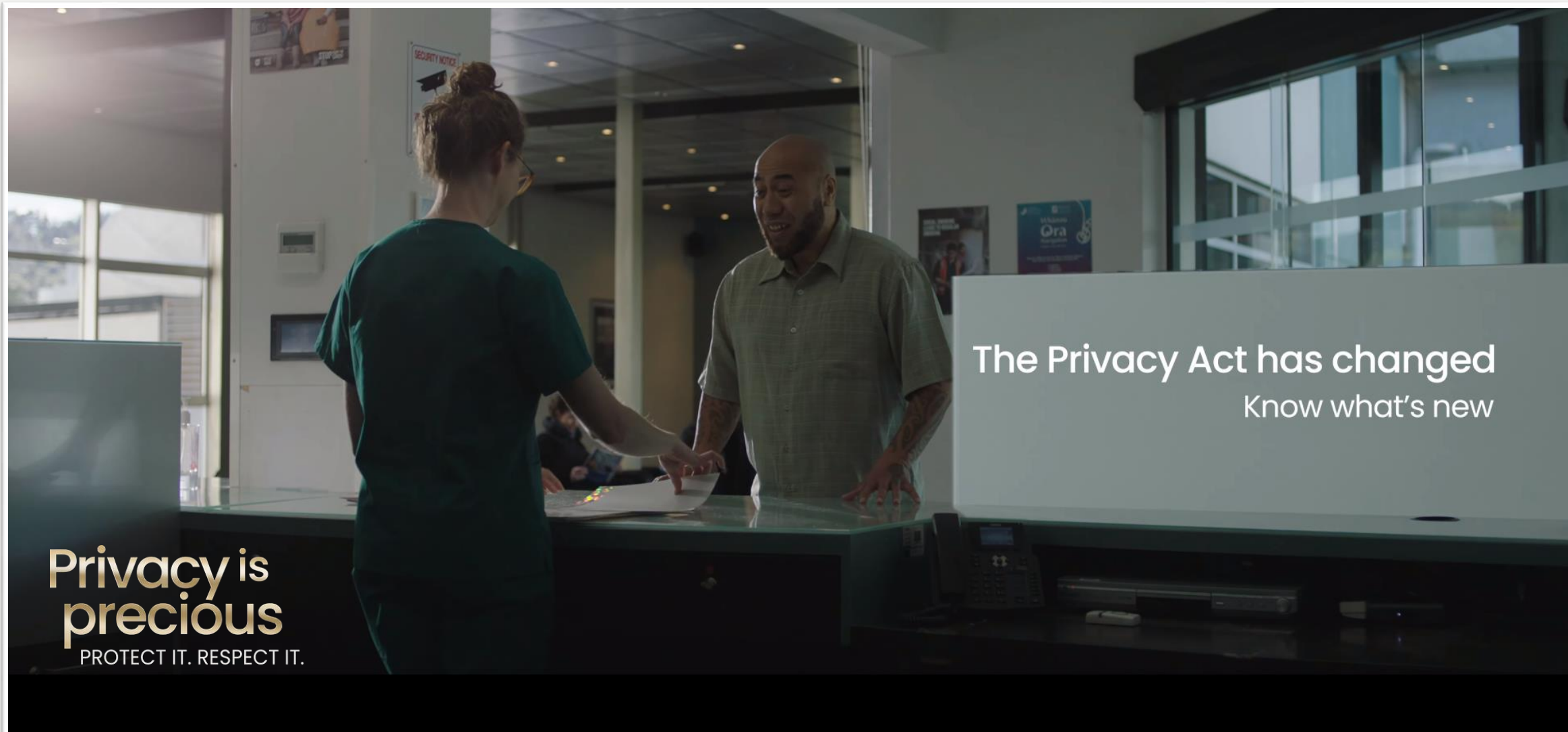

The privacy principles

Collecting personal information

1. Only collect personal information you need
2. Get it directly from the individual when possible
3. Be open about what you are going to do with it
4. Be fair about how you get it

Holding personal information

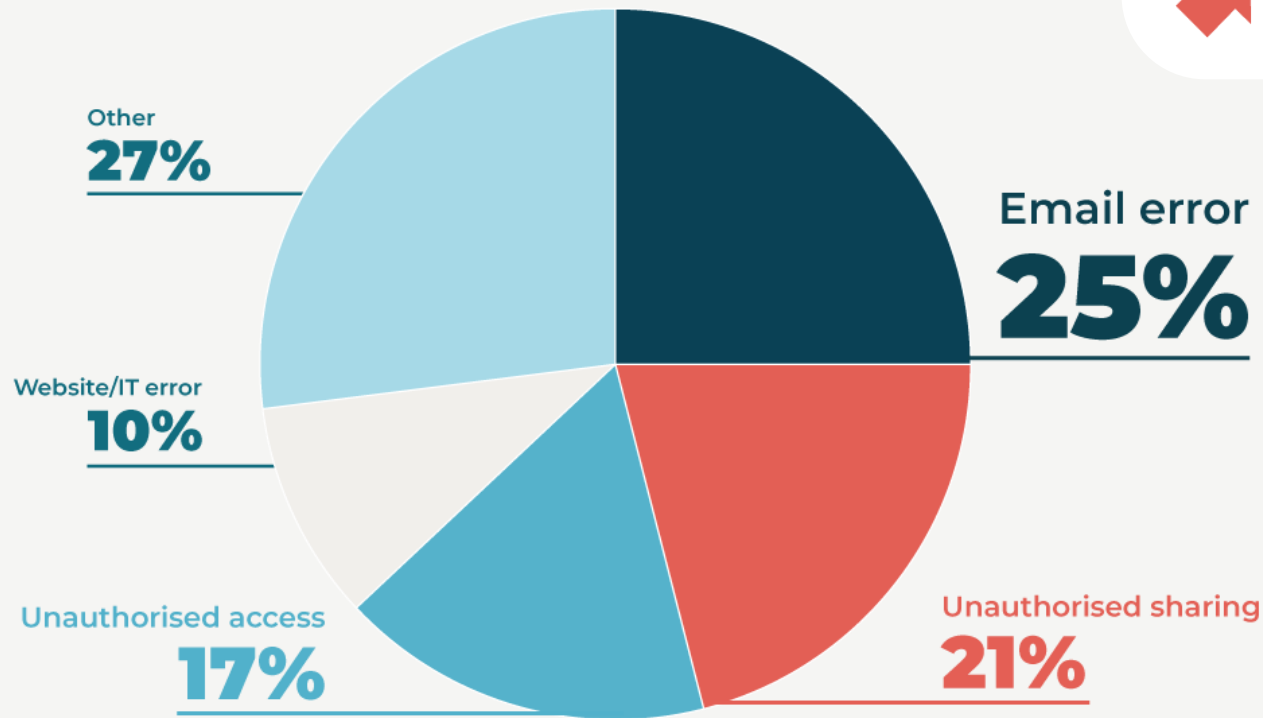
5. Keep it secure
6. Let people see their own information
7. Correct it if the person thinks it is wrong

Using and disclosing personal information

8. Make sure it is accurate before you use it
9. Dispose of it when you no longer need it
10. Only use it for the reason it was collected
11. Only share it if you have a good reason
12. Only send it overseas if it will be adequately protected
13. Only use unique identifiers when it is clearly allowed

Notifiable privacy breaches

Most common serious breaches by type



97% increase in the number of breaches reported to us compared to the preceding six months.

Compliance and Regulatory Action

OPC has developed a **Compliance and Regulatory Action Framework (CARAF)** to be open and transparent in our approach to regulatory and compliance activities.

extent or risk of harm to individuals

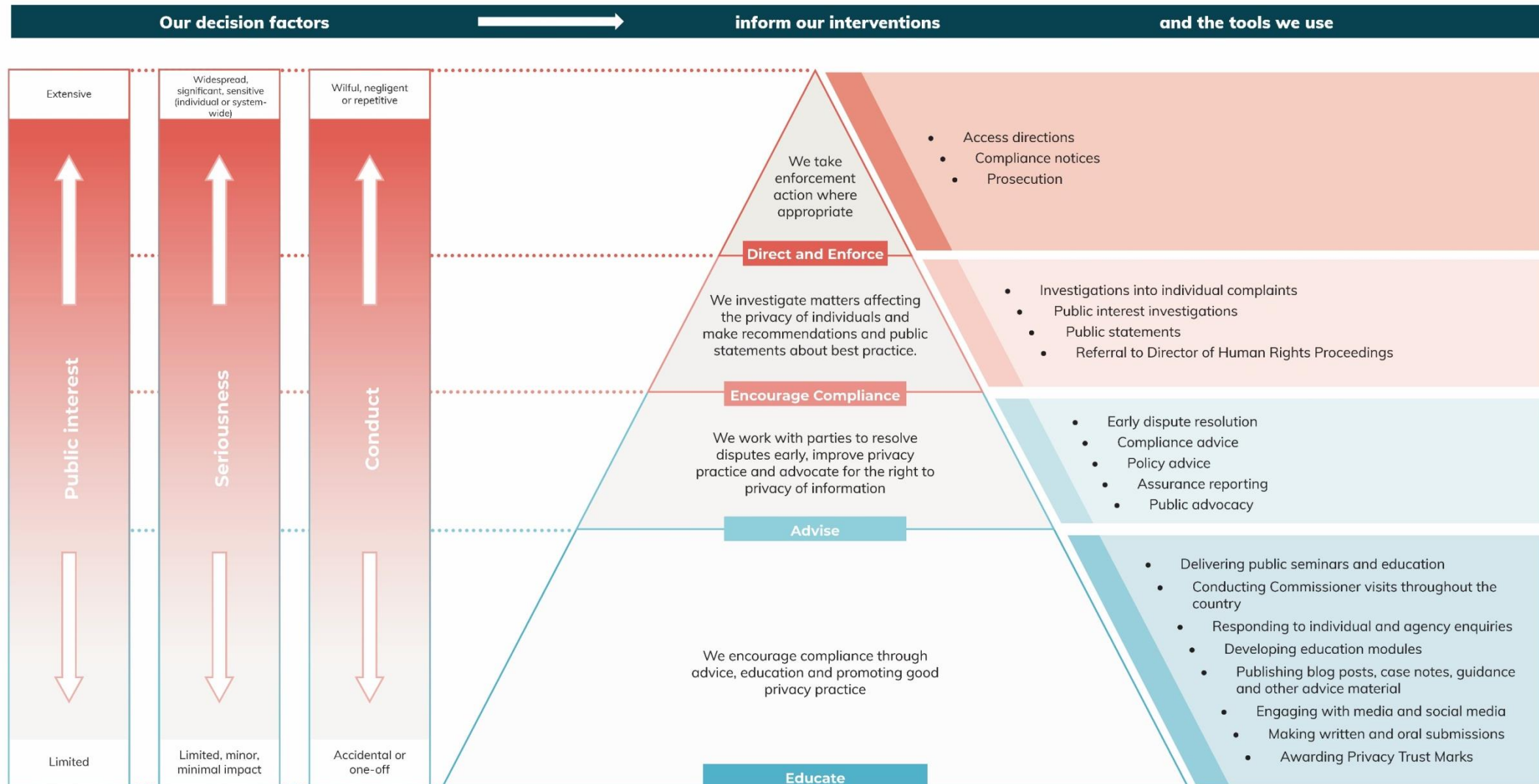
public interest/benefit

conduct of the individual or agency



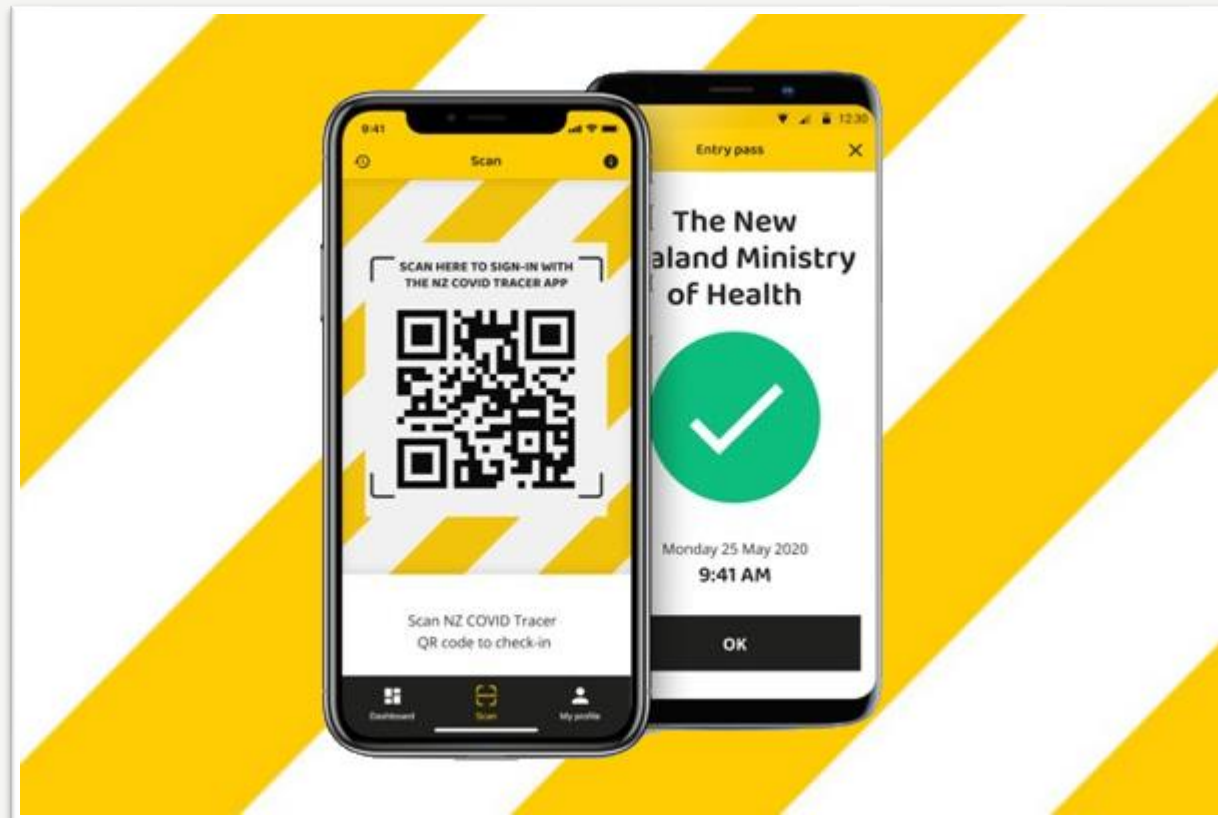
